TTG builds the capacity of our teachers through innovative, learner-centered pedagogical approaches and provides opportunities for professional development.

Recognizing that collaborative work and cooperative learning are critical in preparing educators with the 21st century instructional skills, TTG provides innovative learning environments through interactive study tours; school walkthroughs; peer-to-peer observation; and cultural immersions.

TTG provides a platform for teachers to participate in "do good, feel good" activities that address community needs.



TTG's non-profit arm, Inclusion Initiative (known as IAMYOU) was commissioned by UNICEF Philippines and The Asia Foundation to implement inclusive education initiatives.

- The Traveling IE Mentorship Program through LACs (Learning Action Cell Sessions), a pilot project in Public Schools in Districts 1 and 5 of Quezon City, to provide practical strategies for teachers in handling learners with disabilities in a regular classroom.



- IAMYOU and TTG as the lead convener in groundwork to push for the Inclusive Education Bill Policy and Advocacy in the Philippines.



The Teacher's Gallery (TTG) is a social enterprise founded from an advocacy for inclusive education. It is currently run by passionate teachers and behind them is an Advisory Board of international and local technical experts in various fields of education. Enjoyment and immersive exploration became the core strategies in carrying out TTG's mission — building the skills and expertise of teachers while enabling a fulfilling, rewarding, and enjoyable experience in the process.

TTG hosted the 2-part 1st International Summit on Inclusive Education supported by international organizations such as Australian Embassy funded Basic Education Sector Transformation (BEST) Program, UNICEF, Save the Children, among others.



TTG was the pioneering secretariat of the Philippine Network for Inclusive Education (PNIE), an organization which operates as the network that can be tapped to provide input from the disability sector about inclusive education and disability related policies.



US-based Inclusive Schools Network supports TTG in its inclusive education advocacy programs and the adaptation of the yearly Inclusive Schools Week (ISW) celebration.
